We promise that your email address will not be revealed to anyone else and it will only be used to keep you advised of Club news. You can permanently cancel at any time.

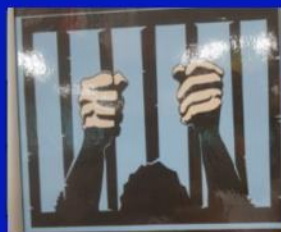
