The restaurant I am pleased to be able to report, continues to attract good numbers and our chef, Darren, is constantly working at updating the weekly menu to keep it fresh and varied. He is also designing our new menu which will include Tapas as one of the dishes.

The Committee is also considering introducing a "Members Hour" period during the week for members only. They are currently looking at the actual timing of this. I find people often quote other premises as serving cheaper drinks than us but I would like to quote a couple of examples of good value in our Club. One of our draught ales is Ansells at only £2.80 a pint. This is a very competitive price. And don't forget our large optics. At 35ml they are almost one Aand half times the usual measure (40% bigger) and a good price at £2.40. When I go into other places and see just how small the normal 25ml measures are I really appreciate just how good our measures are.

Membership continues to grow and we now have 1,030 members with another dozen on the waiting list. To new members this year I say welcome aboard. I hope you are enjoying our club and that you will support us as much as possible.

As usual, can I please ask you to keep an eye on our Facebook page and our new website for the latest Club news. Watch out also for our regular Mailchimp emails which also give updates of what is on at the Club.
